NEW COVID-19 CASES

As of August 11, there are 40 active cases in Yukon. As a result of decreasing case counts and **no new** outbreaks the COVID-19 situation in Yukon is improving! Today, 80% of eligible Yukoners (ages 12+) have been vaccinated.

VGFN COMMUNITY EMERGENCY ACT

Old Crow remains at a **high-risk level** under the COVID-19 Emergency Declaration (until the numbers drop to 39 or lower) until **November 15, 2021**. As such, please:

- Continue wearing a mask inside any public buildings
- Gather **only** with people in your two-household bubble
- Isolate for 2-weeks when entering Old Crow (**unless you provide proof of full vaccination**)
- Immediately isolate and call the Nursing Station if you feel two or more symptoms of COVID-19, or if you have

been in direct contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19

1st and 2nd dose vaccines are **available today**, August 12, from 11:00 AM – 5:00 PM at the Old Crow Health Centre.
