## Recent News

### CASES & OUTBREAK UPDATE

The active case count in the Yukon has been under 25 since September 1. There are **no** confirmed cases in Old Crow.

A student at Porter Creek Secondary tested positive for COVID-19. Contact tracing is underway and four Grade 9 and 10 classes at the school are being instructed to monitor for symptoms, and self-isolate if necessary.

A death from COVID-19 was confirmed yesterday. The individual was hospitalized in Whitehorse and was not fully vaccinated.

The outbreak at the Copper Ridge seniors' facility in Whitehorse is now considered "stable." Last week, one resident and one staff tested positive. No others have tested positive, and 95% of residents are vaccinated.

### PROOF OF VACCINE CERTIFICATE

Yukon government is introducing a proof of COVID-19 vaccination that's "more secure" than the card given when you got your shots.

Yukoners must apply to receive this **credential**, which can be sent by email or mail.

### VGFN COMMUNITY EMERGENCY ACT IN EFFECT

Old Crow remains at a **high-risk level** under the VGG COVID-19 Emergency Declaration until **November 15, 2021**.

Please:

- Continue wearing a mask inside any public buildings
- Gather **only** with people in your two-household bubble
- Isolate for 2 weeks when entering Old Crow (**unless you provide proof of full vaccination**)
- Self isolate **immediately** and call the Nursing Station at **966-444** if you feel sick.
