CASE AND OUTBREAK UPDATE

There are currently **no** confirmed cases in Old Crow. Of the 217 people in the community eligible for a vaccine, 87% are fully vaccinated, and 97% have at least one dose.

Earlier this week, an outbreak was confirmed at Johnson Elementary School in Watson Lake. Students and staff in grade one and four classes are being tested and are self-isolating.

Yukon Government issued no other new exposure notices this week, but several shared last week remain active.

THIRD VACCINATIONS

Yukon Government approved third doses of COVID-19 vaccines for severely

immunocompromised individuals, including those:

- Receiving treatment for solid tumour or hematologic malignancies
- Receiving certain immunosuppressive therapies
- Who had a solid organ transplant
- With Stage 3 or advanced HIV infections

Please call the nursing station for more information at **966-444** on who qualifies for a third dose, and to schedule a vaccination appointment.

VGFN COMMUNITY EMERGENCY ACT IN EFFECT

Please continue:

- Wearing a mask inside any public buildings
- Gathering **only** with people in your two-household bubble
- Isolating for 2 weeks when entering Old Crow **if** you're not fully vaccinated
- **Immediately** self-isolating and calling the Nursing Station at **966-444** if you feel sick.
