





## INTERNATIONAL BORDERS CLOSED TO ALL NON-ESSENTIAL TRAVEL DO NOT TRAVEL INTO ALASKA BY RIVER.



Please be advised if you want to travel to Alaska that:

1. International borders are closed to non-essential travel until further notice.
2. You must always notify local RCMP as well as Alaska State authorities before departure either way.
3. Non-compliance will result in legal action.

### 6 Steps to Staying Safe

|  <b>1</b> Physical distancing – keep 2 metres away from everyone who's not a member of your household     |  <b>3</b> Stay home if you're feeling sick  |  <b>5</b> Limit travel to rural communities   |
|  <b>2</b> Wash your hands frequently with soap and water, or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol |  <b>4</b> Don't gather in groups of more than 10 people and remember to keep 2 metres apart |  <b>6</b> Self-isolate if you've just returned to the territory or if you've been in contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 |
