THE JOB

Reporting to the Director of Natural Resources, this position is responsible for managing a diverse portfolio consisting of a broad array of fish, wildlife, and habitat related plans, legislation, research projects, and occupies a lead role in local, regional, national, and international issues. Participation in government-to-government consultations, delivery of programs and services within Vuntut Gwitchin settlement lands and traditional territory, and collaborative development of resource-related legislation is also vital. This position works closely with the public and fosters strategic relationships with co-management groups, other First Nation, Territorial and National governments.

THE CANDIDATE

The ideal candidate will hold a Degree or diploma in one or more of the following: natural or renewable resource management, land management, environmental studies, or the equivalent in training and experience. You will have knowledge of Umbrella Final Agreement (UFA), and Vuntut Gwitchin First Nation Final Agreement (VGFNFA); knowledge of land management issues; legislation affecting First Nations both locally and nationally; and knowledge of the principles and practices of land resource planning and management. You must be able to problem solve, prioritize tasks, manage time, have excellent organizational skills and deal with the public in a professional manner.
