**The Job:**

Reporting to the Health, Social & Recreation Director, this position is responsible for managing a variety of health and recreation programs and services and staff. This position manages the day-to-day activities, long term goals and work plans for health and recreation to VGFN citizens living in Old Crow. This includes supervising the Home and Community Care Coordinator, and Community Recreation Coordinator and Community Van Driver.

**The Candidate:**

The ideal candidate will hold a diploma or degree in one or more of the following: health/social science, or humanities field, or comparable work experience and training. The candidate must have knowledge of the Umbrella Final Agreement (UFA), Self Government Agreement (SGA) and First Nations Final Agreement (FNFA). Be aware of Yukon First Nation government systems; knowledge of health and recreation issues and legislation affecting First Nation peoples both locally and nationally; knowledge of federal and territorial funding programs for First Nations; knowledge of project management; knowledge of the principles and practices of health and recreation planning and management.

**Pay Range**

\$75,510 - \$90,612 per annum plus an excellent benefit package

This is a full-time term position based on 65 hours biweekly. (6.5-hour workday 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. & 1:00 to 4:30 p.m.)
