### UPDATE: OLD CROW SOLAR PROJECT

The Old Crow Solar Project is now generating power for the community, following the successful completion of stage one commissioning! Phase two of the project is underway, and workers will be coming into our community to install a battery energy storage system and microgrid controller.

We are collaborating with ATCO Electric Yukon and Clark Builders to maintain the highest COVID-19 precautions and we thank them for their concerted efforts to protect our community.

### CRITICAL WORKERS IN OLD CROW

#### No-Contact Policy

Critical workers are aware of the precautions we have in place to protect our community and are expected to follow them. All workers must avoid non-essential contact with our citizens and residents of Old Crow.

#### 14-Day Self-Isolation

Critical workers coming from outside the Yukon are completing their 14-day self-isolation at the Old Crow chalet and their worksite. All out-of-territory workers will be tested for COVID-19 before travelling. If their test is negative, they will be allowed to go outside for walks and fresh air during self-isolation, but must avoid all contact with our community members.

#### Old Crow Chalet Closed Until Project Completion

Critical workers from outside the Yukon will be staying at the Old Crow Chalet for the duration of the project. The chalet will be closed to visitors during the project period and will follow the cleaning protocols set by Yukon Government.

**Please respect the protocols that ATCO Electric Yukon and Clark Builders have put in place to keep our community safe. Don't visit the ATCO generation facility or the Old Crow Chalet, and keep your distance from workers.**
